The outbreak of COVID-19 brought down the economic activities across the world. The Pandemic and global lockdown represent unprecedented challenges for the skill development ecosystem. The lockdowns have had an immediate impact on the world economy that varies dramatically across sectors and regions. Unfortunately people with disabilities have been the worst hit. They belong to the unorganized sector, are doing petty shop keeping, trading, roadside selling. All this has come to a stand-still. The ones that are formally employed have lost jobs as businesses have closed down. BPA has been providing Ration kit support to people with disabilities from day one of lock down. BPA has already provided support to 46000 people with disabilities from Gujarat, Rajasthan and Odisha. The second wave of Covid 19 pandemic was very dangerous, the covid curfew and restrictions have made lives difficult for persons with disabilities. The BPA has been providing these kits with the help of Corporates, donors and well-wishers.

SHARING THOUGHTS



What a Year! In our 4 decades of association with the BPA, we have never witnessed the kind of time that we have seen in the past year. There have been moments of extreme sorrow and grief, days of optimism and cheer, days of waiting for the situation to improve and days which suddenly seems formal. The highlight of this pandemic has been that the BPA worked incessantly and tirelessly without a break. Our 35 staff members could win over Covid and they are back to regular work.



The dedicated team of BPA staff members railled around to ensure that services to the suffering did not stop. All educational programmes suddenly halted but what bloomed and prew was the virtual and online trainings. Children got services through the audio and video media at their door steps thanks to technology. Despite the complete lockdown, our School of Physiotherapy could erroin ewa students in the new batch, teach and conduct exams through virtual means. Our Technology. Centre developed an innovative App as a part of Tanya Computer project to teach and evaluate performance through virtual means.

The teachers and students proved very creative and made many videos which are highly instructional and which are available on the BPA website and uploaded on You Tube. So far, more than 100,000 people have seen these videos.

The BPA realized that mobile phones were essential for the continuity of education. Navin Fluorine International Ltd and Padmanabh Mafatial Group came to our rescue for distributing 400 mobile phones. Janjyot Investments, DP World, HDFC Credila, Razorpay, MedusInd, Bandhan Bank, Indian Oil Corporation, Concord Biotech were our major contributors. Our other supporters are listed in the CSR pages of this report.

Our work in the pandemic started with mask making and spiraled up to distribution of dry ration kits for the survival of persons with disabilities who had lost their occupations. We went on to collaborate in running of a covid Care Service Hospital and distribution of oxygen concentrators. Our donors from USA like Rameshbhai Shah generously helped us. Our distribution of Stop Hunger Kits has crossed the figure of 35,000 with a target of 50,000 such kits

The BPA shared its technical expertise by organizing a series of theme based webinars throughout the year. It was a great time of reaching out to thousands of people from the confines of our own offices. The BPA staff together have participated in more than 45 different webinars throughout the year.

Our Porecha Eye Hospital continued its services in the very infectious times too. Our regular donors like Inductotherm ensured that the free surgeries for patients continued. Our new Smt. Bellaben & Yogeshbail Patel Eye Hospital work came to a standstill due to the pandernic but we made use of the time to finish all the legal formalities required for the setting up of the hospital. Donors also came in and promised their mite to the hospital. The K.K. Shah Sabarkantha Arogya Mandal and Samta Vikas Chartalbei Frust (SVCT) worked very hard with us in this. The SVCT also helped for raise funds for the ration kits.



The year also saw some very tragic moments. Our BPA staff members Mr. Dilip Shah, Mr. Ambalal Patel, Mr. Zakir Sipai, Mr. Rahim Khan Pathan passed away during the year. Our devoted volunteer Mr. Khazanchi also could not come out of the corona infection. Mrs. Bellaben



MOBILE PHONES FOR STUDENTS FOR ONLINE EDUCATION



The pandemic almost made the world stop. All schools and educational institutions remained closed and the Blind People's Association was worried as to how to reach educational services to children with visual impairment and multiple disabilities in their own homes. The digital platform was the only viable option and the parents of all the children were contacted on phone. Children without disabilities were pursuing education through the digital platform and this education was then discussed with each parent over the phone, and then each parent was given a monthly educational plan for each child, and according to this plan, education, training and therapy were given to the children sitting at home in digital mode. At the same time, the blind students are also sent recorded material through the mobile phones of their parents along with detailed information of each lesson, and their questions were also answered by phone. Some parents who had mobiles could use them for enabling their blind children to study.







But unfortunately, the parents of most of the disabled children were so poor that they did not even have a mobile, using the neighbour's number. As the students and their parents are poor, the BPA decided to approach Corporates to sponsor mobile phones for blind students. As can be seen mobile phones are not a luxury and are part of educational devices for the blind. The BPA approached Navin Fluourine International Ltd. for help under CSR and the company and its Chairman Mr. Vishad Mafatlal very gladly sanctioned a total of 230 mobile phones to be distributed around Ahmedabad, Bharuch, Surat and Bhavnagar.

EDUCATION

MINNIE CAMA SECONDARY & HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL

Started as one of the first foundational initiatives, in 1964, and later supported by the Cama family, today the school offers State Government certified curriculum to 220 differently abled students each year, at Primary, Secondary & Higher Secondary levels. In addition, the students also get the opportunity to excel in several other fields such as, singing, dancing, drama, fashion shows, essay writing and sports. The school is equipped with 35

computers which also prepares students as Technology literate at basic and intermediate levels, and which also offers special coaching courses to interested students who wish to pursue careers in Computer Technology, Banking and several other related government and private sector. The school boasts of 100% results in state board examinations. All syllabus material for all grades is available in Braille and Audio.

LIONS METROPOLITAN SHAKRIBEN MANGALDAS MUSIC SCHOOL

One of the oldest and among the first initiatives for persons with visual impairment started by Our Founder Late Shri Jagdish K. Patel, in 1961, it was initiated by teaching 'the prarambhilk' (elementary) and 'the Madhyama' (intermediate) levels of Indian Classical Music. As the enrollment increased, and more interested aspirants steadily continued to opt for this course, it was officialized eventually into a full fledged Music School for Indian Classical Music, with affiliation from 'Gandharva Mahavidhyalaya' in Miraj, Maharashtra, offering all the way upto 'Shiksha Vishanad' (Masters in Indian Classical Music). Students at this school are taught by some of the finest teachers of Indian Classical Music. Today the school boasts of its graduates



having become accomplished employed singers, musicians, music teachers, radio & TV Artists, and in related jobs, and also rendering their own classes in Indian Classical Music.



NANDINI RAMESH GANDHI SCHOOL OF PHYSIOTHERAPY

Started in 1983, it became the first such two year course in India, certified by the Gujards Tates Education Board, eventually expanded to a three year Professional Diploma, recognized and Certified by Ahmedabad University. The trained physiotherapists are able to get jobs in hospitals or start their own Physiotherapy Clinic. The BPA School provides Physiotherapy sessions on a daily basis to all poole needing these services in Ist Clinic on the main campus.



JAPANESE MEDICAL MANUAL THERAPY SCHOOL

In 2013, new specialized two year professional course called "Japanses Medical Manual Therapy (JMMT)" was brought to India with the help of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) to train persons with visual impairment as Indian Master Trainers in this therapy. This course is recognized by Sukuba University, Japan and Teacher Trainers have been trained by noted Japanses: Therapy Expert, Jath C. Stasids BPA has trained 5 Master Trainers and 60 students as Therapists. This year we have admitted 13 new students for the course. This two-year course has before Students to get jobs in Brotles, Spas and Rebab Centres as Therapists. The trained 5 Master Trainers and 60 students are gainfully employed.



INCLUSIVE SCHOOLING

ALL ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED THROUGH VIRTUAL MEANS

SAMMILIT PATHSHALAS at NAAZ & BAVLA

These two Sammilit Pathshalas gives primary education to nondisabled children and children with disabilities and children who are abandoned, ophass and underprivileged. The Naza centre provides residential services to Children with Mental Retardation, Autism, Cerebral Palya and Multiple Disabilities. Presently there are 41 students receiving services of which 23 are girls. Most of the female residents are orphans. Students are provided training in life skills, functional literary and vocational trades. The goal of the centre is for all children to have a smile on their faces and be very happy as part of Naza family. People from far and near communities visit the centre and organize many activities for children and celebrate festivals with them.

Both schools have around 400 children out of which around 100 children have disabilities.

Both schools are recognised by the Department of Primary Education, Government of Gujarat.

The School at Bavla is funded by Reena Bhagwati of Bhagwati Spherocast and at Naaz by Medusind Solutions India Pvt. Ltd.









DISTANCE EDUCATION

In collaboration with IGNOU [Indira Sandin National Open University, New Delhi] and BAOU (Dr. Babasaheb Ambedian Open University, Ahmedabad), and approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India, we at, BPA facilitate four different Courses, as well as Study Centers, for educating Special Teachers (Rehabilitation

Professionals) in the field of visual impairment, hearing impairment, intellectual and multiple disabilities. Since 2009, more than 500 persons have graduated as Special Teachers and have also passed the Foundation Course, Special Bachelors in Education, Post-Graduate and Advanced Diploma.



VOCATIONAL & PROFESSIONAL TRAINING

SOMABHAI LALLUBHAI MULTI-CATEGORY WORKSHOP

A part of Adult Training Center, it provides practical training to People with Disabilities in the trades of Cutting and Tailoring, Calipers, Offset Printing and Binding, General Mechanic, Motor Rewinding, Carpentry, Plumbing and Electrical fields. The building also houses the designing & manufacturing of all Ortho-Prosthetic Devices equipments and Assistive Aids, as well as Canes for Persons with Visual Impairment and tricycles for those with Locomotor Disabilities.

INDUSTRIAL TRAINING CENTRE

Cama Computer Centre : Among the most opted of Courses and high in demand, the enrolled students become Data Entry Operators, Computer Operators, Desktop Publishing Professionals, HTML Coders, Computer Programmers, and Computer Software Operators



(including Corel, TALLY Accounting, MS Office, Adobe and More), who are given placement in private, public and government sectors, with gainful employment.

Arti Mrugesh Doctor Beauty, Hair & Skin Care Centre : Specially for Women with

Disabilities, this Course enables students to learn beauty treatment & make up. hair and skin care, with job prospects in beauty parlors



up Beauty Kit at the end of the course which enables them to be selfemployed and take independent orders.

Shirin Cyrus Dalal Telephone Operator-cum-Receptionist: This course renders training to the persons with visual impairment in telephone operating-cum-receptionist.





Offset Printing: Started initially for inhouse printing needs. today it renders training in modern Offset Printing followed by on the job training to in-house/ residential as well as



mental retardation and locomotor disabilities. Over the decades, its students have got jobs in private, public & government printing presses/publishing companies.

Cutting and Tailoring : Initially started for

women with disabilities for their self-sustenance as a home based micro business, today it attracts men as well. After completion of training. students get first hand



training by industry experts. Trainees have got jobs in large scale ready-made garments and other clothing factories.

Dahiben Stenography English Trade: This course, renders training to persons with visual impairment in English language Stenography.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE FOR PERSONS WITH MULTIPLE DISABILITIES

The Vocational Training Centre has 25 trainees who receive skill training in various trades such as block printing, tie and dve, decorative paper bags making, jewellery making, paper plate, paper bowl, decorative diya, wall hanging, other artistic and festival materials.

Vocational Training Centre staff and trainees participated in various exhibitions, including Ahmedabad Shopping Festival, Exhibition at Corporate Offices and Residential Complexes. Many also do work independently i.e. Nandlal Gautam does block printing on bed sheet and dupattas. Alay Patel makes all kinds of paper bags, and Rishi Kankuwala does good decoration on paper bags and envelopes.

All trainees at this centre enjoy their hard work. All parents are happy with the training of their children

BPA JODHPUR CENTRE

BPA Jodhpur Centre has been working for the past decade for the rehabilitation of persons with disabilities in and around Jodhpur. Community Based Rehabilitation Project was implemented in Bhopalgarh and Mandore Blocks. The project resulted in the starting of the Prayas Day Care Centre with the help of Gruh Finance in 2019 (now Bandhan Bank). Dr. O.P.N. Calla, Mr. Madhosingh Bhandari and Mr. Shivkumar Soni are the active Trustees of the Centre.











BPA - USHA SILAI SCHOOL

For the empowerment of women with disabilities, it is essential to involve them in income generation activities. Their financial independence makes them more confident and self-reliant. This self-reliance is the only true form of empowerment. BPA is aimed at empowering women with disabilities in rural areas financially, and providing them with a regular income. In collaboration with Usha International Itd, the USHA Classical and Satellite School Program has been running in Gujarat for the last 8 years. Under this program 725 women with disabilities have been engaged in Tailoring and Cutting teaching and income generation through stitching work. These women with disabilities act as a master trainer to train other women and girls in their village. These women also stitch designer dresses for Usha International Ltd after receiving training under Usha International's Fashion Label Project.



During the year 2020-2021, more 20 women with disabilities from South Gujarat joined this movement as master trainers, and 20 women with disabilities from Central Gujarat joined as Satellite school learners. The 10 women with disabilities from Tribal Dang district and 10 women with disabilities from Valsad District were given a training for 9 days, and provided Sillai machine to start own business and for giving a training to other women and girls in their respective village.

These trained women with disabilities stitched masks in the pandemic time, and earned their livelihood and provided a big support to their family, and community.

BPA has been specially featured in the NDTV show for its outstanding work in promoting, empowering women with disabilities under USHA Sillai School Program. The coverage link is as given below.

Y4J

Blind People's Association has been a partner with Youth4Jobs Foundation, Hydrabad for skill development and placement support to the persons with disabilities in Gujarat. BPA has provided infrastructure supports to Y4J Foundation for placement linked skill development program for persons with disabilities.

The last year was very challenging for skill development and placement of persons with disabilities as Corona Virus Pandemic and lock down declared by the Government of India. The lock down has affected a lot of the employees with disabilities who were in jobs. The special entrepreneurship program was introduced to support such employees with disabilities, for their livelihood.

The physical training was completely impossible to organize, as a measure, virtual training program was organized for persons with disabilities. The training details are as given below.

The Covid 19 Pandemic was a big challenge as well as a learning to us. The people with disabilities were losing the jobs initially, and there was less opening in the job market. Unlocking phase had brought some hope, and encouragement as the previous employers had started approaching to recruit persons with disabilities. During the year, 72 persons with disabilities had been supported for the placement, and 48 persons with disabilities were supported for self-employment. The placement tratio against the trained candidates is 45%. The placement details are as given below.

CBR PROJECT IN KAPADWANJ

Blind People's Association is a technical partner of Shri V.S.Gandhi Charitable Trust, Kapadwanj, V.S. Gandhi Charitable Trust has been implementing a Comprehensive Community Based Inclusive Development Project in the block of Kapadwanj, Kheda district Gujarat. The project has made very significant development that helped people/children with disabilities to access and avail entitlements, accessing mainstream services, and increased the participation of people with disabilities and their family members in socio-economic, and cultural activities at community level. Facilitating services for persons with disabilities in Covid 19 was challenging, the CBID field staff worked very hard and intensively to provide relief and rehabilitation services to the people with disabilities. The CBR Field Staff had provided Dry Ration kits to 321 families of persons with disabilities of Kapadwanj Block. In addition to this, regular services for rehabilitation has been continued. The following table shows the various services were provided to the people with disabilities in the vear 2020-2021.

TANYA COMPUTER CENTER (TCC)

Blind People's Association (India) runs Tanya Computer Center (TCC) at four locations in Gujarat. These centers provide computer literacy and trainings to people with visual impairment and low vision. Covid 19 pandemic was a big challenge to these centres to provide computer trainings to the blind and low vision trainees as it was not possible for Trainees to attend classes physically at the Center.

The team of Tanya Computer Centers developed a mechanism to provide computer trainings in lock down situations. Virtual training programs for the candidates were started though it was really difficult to provide this training to the blind and low vision people who were completely new to computers and technology. The TCC team worked very hard and developed a methodology for effective computer training. Under TCC training program, a total of 172 blind and low vision persons have been trained. As this was virtual training as mentioned earlier, the candidates did not need to take leave from their job, college, school etc. The candidates found it very convenient to attend the training program. This was a completely new learning for the TCC Team.

When the Govt. of Gujarat allowed us to open our training institutes, the TCC was reopened, and provided trainings to blind and low vision persons at the TCC Centers. The Center wise Details of TCC are as given below.





ADVOCACY AND ADJUSTMENT TRAINING



Due to Covid situation, we couldn't organize any residential adjustment training to people who recently acquired disability. However, in exceptional cases, we have provided need based Mobility and computer training to Mr. Plyush Doshi-a government employee, Mr. Pallav Bhatt-a travel agent and Ms. Kavita Thakor-a housewife who wanted immediate support after losing sight.

Even in this pandemic, we have been receiving requests for the residential adjustment training. 12 people with visual impairment are enrolled for the training but still awaiting our response. Once, the situation gets normal and hostels are open, we will call them for the training.

On the other hand, department had conducted series of online programs addressing Mental Health issues of female students with visual impairment, Health and Hygiene issues of women with visual impairment, Diet in pandemic situation etc to keep motivating the clients.

BPA HOSPITAL COMPLEX - BAREJA

The Bareja General Hospital Trust donated a piece of land measuring nearly 5 acres to the organization for the purpose of setting up an eye hospital. This was the turning point in BPA's commitment to sight saving. It approached a local donor Mr. Nalin Porecha who donated the initial amount for setting up of a hospital in the memory of his parents. The hospital which is renamed as the "Porecha Eye Hospital" is now a full-fledged 50 bedded eye hospital – the only one of its kind



on the Ahmedabad-Baroda Highway at Kheda. The campus is now a hospital complex consisting of the following.

rifer orderlar eye nospiral province schipplierlarisher Resuper specialty retina unit at Bareja is well equipped with OCT, Argon Leser, Fundus camera, Yag Laser, slit lamp Auto refractometer, Non-contact tonometer etc. Porecha eye hospital Bareja has fully equipped international level tertiary care facilities for retinal services.

We treat patients from all parts of Gujarat and also nearby areas of Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh. Our sup up is providing treatment for diabetic lasers, retinal intravitreal injections to treat retinal haemorrhages, vitrectomy machine to treat complex retinal detachments and perform double and triple procedures in conjunct with corneal and cataract surgeons.

We cover all the patients with Diabetic Retinopathy, Hypertensive Retinopathy, Age Related Macular Degenerations, ROP, Glaucoma, Optic Neuropathies of various kinds, Retinal Detachments, Tractional Detachments, RD due to ROP, uveitis and hereditary retinal disease.

We perform medical procedures in the form of lasers anglography and various type of intra-ocular injections at no cost or minimal costs. With all high-end advanced technologies, we have performed complex retinal surgeries like retinal detachment surgery, macular hole surgeries, vitreos haemorrhage surgeries, vitrectomy for endophthalmitis, paediatric trauma and retinal procedures, traumatic retinal detachment with removal of intra-ocular foreign bodies, combined corneal and retinal procedures, combined cataract and retinal procedures. Dr. Ruchi Maheta (Retinal Specialist) is providing her service as retina surgeon at Porecha Eye Hospital, Bareja.

GLAUCOMA UNIT

The Glaucoma Unit is providing diagnostic and therapeutic services in various diseases of Glaucoma. Diagnosing and treatment of primary closed and open angle



glaucoma, secondary open and closed angle glaucoma.

We are well equipped with Humphrey Perimetry, OCT, 3 blindness and of mirror gonio lens, SLT with Yag for diagnosing and visual impairment treating Glaucoma. Dr. Deep Joshi provides the which is responsible department both clinical and surgical services.

PEDIATRIC OPHTHALMOLOGY UNIT

The pediatric ophthalmologist unit has been started for providing comprehensive pediatric eve care services to the children in need. The department provides services of



cataract, post-operative vision rehabilitation, pediatric refraction, amblyopia management, pediatric and adult Cataract Department. squint surgeries, nasolacrimal duct probing and others as per requirement. Dr. Anupama Vyas is providing her services in the pediatric ophthalmology unit as pediatric eye specialist for both clinical and surgical services.

CORNEA UNIT

The Cornea Unit is providing various services like penetrating Keratoplasty-Optical, Therapeutic, Lamellar Keratoplasty-DSEK, DMEK, DALK, SLK, C3R (Corneal



Collagen Crosslinking-Riboflavin) for Keratoconus, Open Globe Injury Repair in blunt trauma, fire cracker injury, Amniotic Membrane Transplantation technique in severe dry eyes, Chemical Injury to eye. Ocular surface reconstruction in Symblepharon, Ankyloblepharon.

SLET Technique (Simple Limbal Epithelial Transplantation) in chemical injury to eye.

The hospital is having Human Organ Transplantation Act (HOTA) permission to undertake Keratoplasty surgery. Our cornea unit is well equipped with Anterior Topography by TMS Tomey (Japan) for diagnosing abnormality in size and shape of cornea, C3R machine for

treating keratoconus and bacterial corneal ulcer, compound microscope by Laborned for diagnosing the infection in non-healing corneal ulcer. Dr. Sumit Chatteriee is providing his service at the hospital as Cornea Consultant and providing both clinical and surgical services.

CATARACT

Cataract is the leading cause of for 48% of world blindness. The



cataract unit of Porecha Hospital routinely performs state-of-the-art phacoemulsification surgery with foldable IOLs surgery. The hospital performs more than 10000 cataract surgery every year with SICS and Phacoemulsification method. We have Alcon Phaco, Johnson's and Johnson's Phaco, Stellaris PC, Advance microscope and all advance equipments and instruments to perform cataract surgery. Dr. Atish Patel provides his services as senior consultant and senior surgeon in the

VITHALBHAI GATORBHAI ORTHOPAEDIC HOSPITAL

Every day a large number of patients visiting for eve problem to Porecha Eve Hospital are mostly from the aged community. As life expectancy is increasing in India because of better health facilities and better



life style management in general community in India, orthopedic problems are more common among aged men than in aged women. Keeping in view the orthopedic problem of old age people coming to the hospital, Orthopedic unit started and not only the old age community has taken benefit of the center but also the PWDs who require corrective surgeries. Dr. Gaurang Bhabor is providing his service in the unit as Orthopedic Specialist, The Shardaben Vitthalbhai Patel Swasthva Kendra gives free treatment to

Routinely we are doing procedures like wax and fungus removal from ears, foreign body removal from nose and ears, diagnostic nasal endoscopy and laryngeal telescopy also. Dr. Mitul Thakker provides his services at the ENT Department as ENTS pecialist.

AUDIOMETRY UNIT

The Lotus Charitable Trust sponsored Audiometry Unit is run under the Porecha ENT Department.



The audiology unit helps people with hearing loss by measuring hearing acuity for variations in sound intensity and pitch and for tonal purity, involving thresholds and differing frequencies.

CHANDRIKABEN SUMANT SHAH GENERAL OPD

Dr. Nitin Shah has donated this service in the memory of his parents. People who are aged and who come for eye surgery have a host of other problems like blood pressure, diabetes and



other disease. The general OPD was started keeping in view the need to provide services to the poor and needy patients in nearby areas and the patients referred from the eye department for fitness before surgery. Dr. Alok Gajjar is providing his services as MD medicine and medical officer in the general OPD department.

PHYSIOTHERAPY UNIT

The Unit handles patients with disabilities, and works to mitigate physical disabilities, dependency and functional deterioration. The physiotherapy unit of the



hospital diagnoses the problem, then plans and provides treatment that aim to restore function or minimize dysfunction after disease or injury. This is achieved through a combination of manual therapy, movement training and the use of physical and electro physical agents.

BPA SATELLITE HOSPITAL AT BHUJ

BPA Modular Operation Theatre Eye Surgical Unit at Bhuj. Wolrd Mundra was inaugurated on 6 June, 2018. This Unit is a branch of the Porecha Eye Hospital and follows the same operating and other protocols. The Unit is providing services of cataract, glaucoma and other minor surgeries and conducts outreach eye care programmes in the far flung areas of Kutch.



VISION CENTRES APPROACH

BPA- Bareja is running Iovision centers in different part of the state in order to provide comprehensive eye care services to the rural, urban slum and tribal masses. The objective of the vision center is to bring basic eye care services to the community by which only patients who need surgical intervention or advanced eye care need will be referred to the base hospital for further intervention. 90% patients with minor eye problems can be treated at the vision Centres which are run by BPA Porecha Eye Hospital. These Centres are well equipped with all diagnostic equipment and trained staff. Thorough understanding of the community structure, their cultural and social beliefs, level of awareness about eye care is another important aspect for the success of any vision center in a specified community.

MOTIYA MUKT (CATARACT FREE) SABARKANTHA


The union of BPA and Samta Vikas Charitable Trust has resulted in the commendable Cataract Free Sabarkantha - Aravali Project. This project has not only enabled patients to get perfect eye sight but has also given them lessons in hygiene, cleanliness and eye health.

Motiva Mukt (Cataract Free) Sabarkantha-Aravali Projects, is a resounding and laudable success with the support from Samta Vikas Charitable Trust, through its four vision centers, not only enables thousands of patients each year, to get perfect eye sight, but also medicines, spectacles and guidelines for hygiene, cleanliness and etiquette.

These vision centres enable patients to be tested, given medicines and spectacles. An Amount of approximately Rs. 40 lacs has been spent on saving sight in Sabarkantha-Arayali, BPA thanks the USA team consisting of Shri Arvind Thekdi, Shri Rasikbhai M. Shah and Shri Rameshbhai P. Shah for their herculean support to this work. Mega Camps were held in the area and around 3000 surgeries were conducted during the year.

Outreach services: Porecha Eye Hospital believes that the poorest of the poor should get services specially if they are unable to visit the hospital for checkup. The hospital has a large outreach team which meets the community and organizes screening camps at prominent locations. People from nearby villages are easily able to come to the

taken to the camp venue. Patients are given medicines and a pair of spectacles free up coast. People needing surgery are taken to the Porecha Hospital in the hospital bus for srgery. Theses outreach camps have helped our work in Sabarkantha and Ahmedabad become very strong.



The Areez Khambhatta Benevolent Trust donates Rs. 20 lacs every year for conducting sight restoration surgeries in the periphery and slums and local areas of Ahmedabad, 20,000 Cataract surgeries have been conducted under this project. The outreach camp team visits the different slums and poorer areas and contacts the local NGO, Youth Club or any such service organization. Pamphlets are distributed in the community about the next camp to be held. Patients line up in a community shelter/panchavat/school compound and eye checkup takes place. Patients needing surgery are taken to the hospital by vehicles and the others are given medicines and advice for managing their conditions.















TRUCKER'S PROJECT FUNDED BY SIGHT SAVERS:

This project named as RAHI Truckers Project provides services through Static vision center at Aslail and camps in different truckers locations and parking. The vision center runs from Monday to Friday and outreach programmes are conducted on Saturday and Sunday. The major objective of the project is to provide better sight to the truckers in a bid to reduce accidents. The Sight Savers has also provided the vision center with multi media for awareness on good practices for of rivers.



NEW SATELLITE EYE HOSPITAL AT VATRAK "SMT. BELLABEN & SHRI YOGESHBHAI PATEL EYE HOSPITAL"

The K.K. Shah Sabarkantha Arogya Mandal at Vatrak, District Sabarkantha has offered the Blind People's Association land free of cost for use for setting up the eye hospital. This land is on the Modasa-Bayad Highway, very close to the Trust hospital at Vatrak. This project is part of a triangular partnership between the Blind People's Association, K.K. Shah Sabarkantha Arogya Mandal and Samta Vikas Charitable Trust. Blind People's Association applied to our BPA Bareja Eye Hospital donors in the US and our dedicated donor Bellaben and Yogeshbaha Patel have agreed to donate Rs. 2 Crores for naming of this hospital. We have received funds for the Operation theatre and Phaco machine of Rs. 35 lakhs from Dineshbhai Shah from the USA. Shri Rameshbhai Shah from USA has already sent \$19000 for the hospital.

The Architect has already drawn up plans. This eye hospital will serve lakhs of poor and needy people from Sabarkantha, Aravalli and neighbouring state Rajasthan to get premier eye care at no cost. This will be the first such hospital in this area. The local community will help in mobilization of patients and other resources for the successful implementation of the project.

The Shilanyas/ground breaking/Bhoomi Poojan ceremony of the hospital was conducted on the auspicious day of 02-02-2020.







INTEGRATION OF PEOPLE WITH SEVERE MENTAL DISORDERS INTO COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION MODEL

This is first of its kind project to serve people with such severe mental illnesses at doorsteps. We work in 9 blocks of Gujarat, Kathlal, Balasinhor, Thasra, Idar, Deesa, Vadhwan, Chotila, Anjar and Dholka. From identification, medical consultation, medicines and counseling services are provided. Till now we have been able to serve 7546 people with mental illness. 137 People have recovered and do not need any medical intervention.

In the year 2019-20, we have provided medicines worth more than Rs. 12 lakhs, 109 people are back in mainstream work. We are very happy to present that 38 people were provided support for self employment, like sewing machine, petti shop, and other equipments.

We have started vocational training unit at Thasra for recovered patients for vocational training. 32 patients come regularly and are involved in tailoring work, Decorative Diya making, wall hangings and paper plates and paper bowl making. This helps them to regain confidence in themselves also family members also develop faith in them and their attitude acts positive.

The project team conducted various community awareness programs like street plays, rally, so that social stigma gets minimized and people with mental illness are not labeled as "MAD" and scary but are treated with human touch.

The project also serves to wandering patients in all project areas. Many of the patients who were locked up for many years also were treated and now living life with dignity.

BPA PALANPUR UNIT: Dr. S.K. Mevada Lions Divyang Education & Training Center is run by the Lions Club of Palanpur Charitable Trust and provides Day Care services to 30 children with Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities with new campus donated by Meheta Parivar.

BPA DEESA UNIT: Nagarpalika Deesa Constructed building for providing services to chilredn with disabilities in Deesa town and gave name of that building as "Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyay Divyang Bhavan - Khushiyo nu Surnamu" This cenre provides services and therapy to 62 children with multiple disabilities.
