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COVID VACCINATIONS AT BPA FIRST DRIVE THROUGH COVID VACCINATION FOR SPECIALLY ABLED



In the light of spreading awareness among citizens to take the Covid-19 vaccine across the nation BPA organized a special Drive through Covid-19 Vaccination Camp for persons with disability. 500+ Specially abled people participated and took free vaccine at the BPA campus within a span of 2 Days on 12-13 June 2021 and set a new world record. The event was supported by Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation, Bankim Pathak Foundation, Saika Mobility Hub, Akhil Hindustan Viklang Sangh and the Blind People's Association. Thanks to Govt of Gujarat and Wagh Bakri Tea Group for supporting this initiative. Thanks to all volunteers for making this event a great success.

People taking advantage of the offer queued up at the centre in vehicles, wheelchairs, and on customised mopeds for their free COVID-19 vaccine shots. "The vaccination process is now more convenient," said Mahendra Chudasma, a 45-year-old man who is visually impaired. "It's a very nice feeling." Despite being a major producer of corona virus vaccines, India faces a huge task in inoculating its 1.3 billion people, partly due to the logistical difficulties of reaching remote areas and also skepticism about the shots. People with disabilities often face additional problems of being unable to reach vaccination sites due to a lack of transport or no ramps at the centres for easy access. Some people have struggled to use a government-mandated smart phone app required to register for shots. Second drive through covid vaccination for specially abled was organized on 12 September, 2021.

A total of 90 persons with psychiatric disorders will be trained in 3 different project locations.

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MEDUSIND CSR SUPPORT FOR EDUCATION OF CHILDREN WITH NAAZ

The Inclusive school is a place where children with and without disabilities study together. The school was reopened after the summer break from 15th June 2021. Virtual education has been provided to the students as the physical classroom activities were restricted by the Govt. of Gujarat. This year Medusind has supported all the recurring expenses of the school which is a very great donation. Every year we celebrate Shala Pravestosav (Festival of School Admission) to motivate students who have been given new admission. This year, physical classroom activities were not allowed. The teachers visited the home of new students and gave them welcome kits. This year, there are 13 new admissions in the school. The teachers had celebrated International Yoga Day in the School, and students joined virtually.

The school teachers visited the village, the students were gathered at one place. This place was either a school, Anganwadi, or house of any students. The main purpose of this initiative was to ensure that the numeracy, writing and reading skills of the students should not be affected, and quality education will be imparted. The children with intellectual disabilities who are in residential care are engaged in kitchen gardening activities, and other vocational activities.

The vaccination of all teachers, attendants, drivers, and other support staff, and adults with intellectual disabilities and multiple disabilities has been done.

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MESSAGE

Community Based Inclusive Development (CBID) has been advocated internationally as the core strategy for improvement in the quality of life of Persons with disabilities (PwDs). CBID was initiated by the World Health Organization, following the Alma-Ata declaration in 1978. It was promoted as a strategy to improve access to rehabilitation services for persons with disabilities in low and middle-income countries, by making optimum use of local resources through collaboration with NGOs and organizations of persons with disabilities.

The international community is currently focusing on the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development Goals, which recognizes the potential of community based inclusive development to accelerate inclusion of persons with disabilities and bridge the digital divide.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the Government of India and the Government of Australia in November, 2018 for cooperation in disability sector. Under the said MoU, the Department of Empowerment for Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan): DEPwD, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India & the Rehabilitation Council of India (RC1) in collaboration with the University of Melbourne, Australia have jointly developed the first Community Based Inclusive Development Programme. This program will be instrumental in developing a pool of community based rehabilitation workers trained to respond to issues concerning persons with disabilities at community level across the country.

I am delighted to launch this Programme together with a CBID guide book. I thank the entire team of the DEPwD, the RCI, the University of Melbourne and other experts for their valuable contribution in developing this programme and preparing the programme Guide book. I hope the programme will be widely accepted across the country.

RCI conducted a 6-days Training of Trainers (ToT) Programme from 16-23 August, 2021 through Virtual Mode in collaboration with University of Melbourne, Australia to prepare trainers to conduct CBID Programme. Dr. Bhushan Punani, Mrs. Nandini Rawal, Mrs. Vimal Thawani, Ms. Kinnari Desai, Mr. Bharat Joshi and Mr. Jyotish Choudhary were nominated to undergo this ToT Programme for smooth conduct of CBID Training as Master Trainers at Blind People's Association. BPA started the first training of CBID batch from 1st October 2021.

PARENTS MEETINGS



13 May 2021: Annual virtual parents meeting of Ashirvad Viklang Trust, Surendranagar and Porbandar. Ms. Vimal Thawani addressed the parents, congratulated their efforts in virtual training, Mr. Bharat Joshi spoke on following general hygiene guidelines at home in covid situation, ration kit help and Give foundation support. Ms. Anjana talked on vaccination, evaluation of students and contact with parents for various activities. Ms. Krupa focused on time table of students at home in vacation time.

Blind People's Association (BPA) was conferred the National Award in the category of Civil Services Organization by President of India Shri Ram Nath Kovind at the 16th National Voters' Day – 25th January, 2020 at Manekshaw Centre in New Delhi. BPA was recognized for its outstanding role in making elections accessible for persons with disabilities. Dr. Bhushan Punani, Executive Secretary of BPA and Member of National Advisory Committee on Accessible Voting received the Award from Hon'ble President on behalf of BPA. The BPA had produced ballet papers, voter ID cards, voter's slips and voter information booklets in Braille for people with visual disabilities. It also promoted accessibility for persons with orthopaedic disability, hearing impairment and deafblindness. BPA produced ballet papers in audio for the first time in the country and also developed voting process in sign language and imparted training to voting booth officials.

Webinar on RoPwD Act-2016

The new act introduced for persons with disabilities is a very comprehensive and powerful act. But, they will be able to benefit only if they are properly informed and educated about this act.

A webinar was organized on features and provisions in RoPwD Act 2016. Mr Bharatbhai Joshi, Deputy Director BPA was invited as a speaker on this topic. His profound study on this topic, wide experience of delivering speeches on this topic in various seminars and webinars and his method of explaining every topic and subtopic in detail made this webinar enriching and interesting.

Mr Joshi began the speech with the brief outline of earlier acts and the need for a new act

Then he gave the outline of this act and gave details of new disabilities added in this act. He then discussed some features that are useful for most of disable persons. The speech was followed by question answers.

Approximately 75 persons participated in this webinar and benefited from this webinar.

New Education Policy 2020

A webinar was held on New Education Policy on April 18 2021. Approximately, 83 persons participated in this webinar. Mr Himanshu Sompura (Secretary Navchetan Andhjan Mandal) and Mr Anil Aneja (President AICB) were invited as speakers for this webinar. Mr Sompura talked about key principles and key features of NEP, radical changes that this policy will bring about in the education system and expected outcomes of these changes. Mr Aneja discussed about the provisions of special education in this act. He also discussed what will be the impact of this policy for students with disabilities.

Creating Accessible E-book

A Two-day webinar on creating accessible E-book on 14 to 24June 2021. 18 participants from Surat learnt creating accessible E-books.

Objectives of this webinar was;

- 1. To explain how is important E-books are for Visually Impaired students for reading purpose nowadays.
- 2. To explain how to create E-book in very details.
- 3. To explain in detail the dos and don'ts in creating E-books. What is heading, how to describe images and how much important for any Visually Impaired persons.

Mr. Himanshu Sompura and Ms. Bharatiben were invited as lecturer for this webinar. The webinar ended with the strong demand for creating more E-books from Gujarat side and will be beneficial for VI persons.

VTCC Online Study Centre

Approved 3 online courses from Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University. These courses are ;

- 1. Certificate Course in Vaidik Maths
- 2 Certificate course in translation
- 3 Certificate Course in Anchoring.

This is a regular weekly programme and it was launched on 22 May 2021 and it's objectives are;

- To enhance and cultivate the interest of the participants in literature and light music
- To identify the creative talents from the visually challenged participants and to train and motivate them to write poetry and prose.
- To invite eminent literary personalities in this programme and thereby to acquaint participants with well-known writers.

For the First time, TCC on-line study centre organized this Two-day programme "From Taste to Health" on cooking by webinar on 27-28 May 2021. Visually challenged participants who know basics of cooking were invited to attend this webinar. 57 participants benefited from this programme.

Objectives of this webinar were;

- 1. To explain that cooking is not just a daily activity but it is both a science and an art.
- 2. To explain the recipe of nutritious and delicious items for brunch, lunch and dinner.
- 3. To explain in detail the dos and don'ts for preparing the food for family members suffering from diabetes, blood pressure and other common problems.

The Speakers were Miss **Nidhi Shah** and Mrs **Abha Nanavati** Their detailed verbal description of every recipe, detailed and satisfactory answers to each question from every participant were the outstanding qualities of the speakers. The webinar ended with the strong demand for organizing at least one webinar every month on cooking.



Gujarati Typing in Mobile Phones Using Physical Keyboard

We all know that typing long mails and other long documents in mobile phones using virtual keyboards is comparatively difficult for VI persons. To overcome this problem, we encourage them to use external or physical keyboards. It brings ease, speed and accuracy in typing directly in their mobile phones. But there were technical difficulties in typing in Gujarati. After proper testing, TCC (BPA) in collaboration with Navchetan Andhajan Mandal, Madhapar organized the first webinar on Gujarati typing in mobile phones using physical keyboards on 23rd May 2021. The experts explained with demonstration how to write Gujarati in mobile phones using external keyboard. This development will allow visually challenged persons to use mobile phones as mini laptops in their classrooms as well as in work places even in situations where they have to type in Gujarati. More than 88 participants benefited from this webinar.

TCC conducts webinars and on-line workshops on topics that enhance creativity, professional skills and broaden their understanding in various topics. A good number of visually challenged persons are associated in the field of music. They include teachers, performers and private tutors. The recent webinar was organized for their benefit. The topic was "**the use of classical music in film songs**". The invited speaker was an eminent singer, a well-known composer and one of the key persons of the orchestra named Khandekar Brothers' orchestra. The webinar was organized from 11 A.M. to 1 P.M. on **April 4 2021.**

Mr. Khandekar divided the topic in three parts. Leading 35 ragas which are frequently used in film songs, leading musicians who have made abundant use of classical music in film songs, and leading singers who have excelled in singing classical based film songs. The best part of the webinar was that Aniketbhai gave many examples in his melodious voice.

Approximately, **80 visually challenged** persons participated in this webinar and enriched their knowledge with a lot of enjoyment.

Programming Course in Python Language




