The Orbit Reader 20TM is simple to use and allows switching between the distinct functions seamlessly. Its stand-alone capabilities include reading, writing, and file management. Orbit Reader 20 starts as a reader displaying the content of files stored on the SDTM card. It allows a person with visual impairment to access information as well as a sighted person.
