Mr. Pranav Desai, Founder of Voice of Specially Aabled People, visited the eyecare programs of the BPA. VoSAP has been supporting cataract and corneal grafting surgeries at the Porecha Eye hospital for the past years. The team consisted of volunteers and Office Bearers of VoSAP. They were shown around the hospital and made aware of the different standard operating protocols of the hospital. They were shown the software that is used and also the various inputs like intraocular lenses and other products used in the surgery. A meeting was also conducted with beneficiaries of the grant from VOSAP. A few persons who were blind earlier due to a corneal injury were given a corneal transplant and now can see again. Dr. Sumeet Chatterji, the corneal surgeon explained how a single cornea could be used on two or more people dependent on the injury to the patient

Distribution Self Employment Kits





Our Kids Shine in High Court



Mitti Café creates employment opportunities for people with disabilities by training and hiring them in their cafes. It is a non-profit organization committed to the cause of employment and livelihoods for people with special needs. They work towards economic independence and dignity for adults with physical, intellectual and psychiatric disabilities and persons from other vulnerable communities. The organization's outreach initiatives also help create awareness about inclusion and disability rights. Blind People's Association (BPA) India successfully implemented its first large-scale artificial limbs project, marking a significant milestone in its journey toward inclusion and rehabilitation. This ambitious initiative was made possible through the generous support of Aavas Financiers Limited, whose

commitment to social responsibility helped bring mobility and independence to those in need. The project primarily focused on individuals with lower limb amputations, while also extending support to those who had lost upper limbs. With a target of 200 beneficiaries from the states of Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Madhya Pradesh, the initiative was designed to reach the unserved and underserved populations, especially in rural and remote regions where access to assistive devices remains limited.
